



STEP 01 The Italian spouse must be registered at the Consulate as an Italian Citizen Residing Abroad (A.I.R.E.).

STEP 02 Obtain the certified copy of your Italian marriage certificate. If your marriage took place outside of Italy the marriage must have been transcribed at the Comune in which the Italian spouse is registered and a certified copy of the marriage certificate must be obtained.

STEP 03 Obtain certified birth certificate of the applicant.

STEP 04 Conduct FBI background check and State Police Clearance in each State that applicant has legally resided since age 14; the documents are valid for use for a period of 6 months.

STEP 05 Authenticate US birth certificate and background checks with Apostille.

STEP 06 Translate birth certificate and background checks into Italian.

STEP 07 Submit wire transfer in the amount of 200 Euro to the Italian Ministry of Affairs (Rome) and then upload the application/documents with payment receipt to their online portal. The application will either be accepted, additional information may be requested, or the application could be denied. This step varies at some Consulate locations.

STEP 08 If the application is approved, the Italian Consulate of the Jurisdiction in which the applicant resides will notify the applicant and spouse to appear in person with the original documents.
